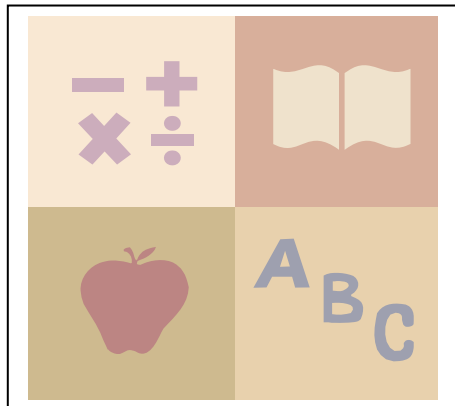

**Lindsey Jones** has experience working in special education and disability law, advising and representing both school districts and parents regarding IDEA, Section 504, and Section 1983 issues. She is admitted and has litigated before the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals, and the federal district courts, state and administrative courts in Arizona. She is the author of the Arizona Risk Retention Trust's *Technical Information Bulletin: Section 504* and is a frequent speaker on special education matters. Currently, Lindsay is the Senior Director for Policy and Advocacy at the Council for Exceptional Children (CEC). In that role, she designs CEC's federal legislative strategy and advocates for CEC's policy agenda before the U.S. Congress and Executive branch departments
